### **Rock n Roll Dallas - Marathon** **Venue/Location: City Hall Plaza** **1500 Marilla St., 75202**

**Sunday, March 25, 2018**  
**8 a.m. - 1 p.m.**  
**Est. Attendance: 16000**

This is an annual Half Marathon race, (13.1 miles). Set up will begin at 7 a.m. On Thursday, March 22 and will include Reunion Lawn and one lane each of Sports Street and Hotel Drive from Reunion Boulevard to Houston Street Viaduct. Sunday, March 25 closures will begin at 3 a.m. near the starting line at Young Street and S. Lamar Street and will roll along with the runners as they move along the route. Attendees will start to gather at 7 a.m. at the starting line with the run and amplified sound starting at 8 a.m. The runners will proceed east on Young Street to Canton Street, left on Exposition Avenue (First Ave.), left on Elm Street (with an access lane for residents), left on Good Latimer Expressway, right on Main Strait, right on Caesar Chavez Boulevard, left on Elm Street (leaving an access lane for DART) until Elm turns into Commerce Street, right on Riverfront Boulevard. (northbound lanes) right on Continental Avenue (eastbound lanes) right on the I-35 off ramp (against traffic flow), merges onto the Margaret Hunt Hill Bridge (eastbound lanes only on Singleton), left on Sylvan Avenue, left on Ft. Worth Avenue (eastbound lanes), turns around on Fort Worth Avenue at Beaver Street, left on Sylvan Avenue then Sylvan turns into N. Tyler Street, left on W. Davis Street, right on Madison Ave, left on East 8th St., left on N. Zang Blvd, right on N. Crawford Street (access lane for NB egress), left on E. Fifth Street, left on Blaylock Drive, right on Colorado Boulevard, left on N. Marsalis Avenue, merge onto the S. Houston Street Viaduct, left on Reunion Blvd. East, left on Sports Street where it will finish and disperse just south of Reunion Blvd. Food will be sold and alcoholic beverages will be provided. Twenty tents varying in sizes (10'x10' – 40'x60') and fifteen stages (15'x 5'x less than 36") will be erected on Reunion Lawn and along the route for the event. Amplified sound will come from live bands performing on the stages and broadcasted music from mile marker speakers along the route. The projected total attendance is 16,000.
